Candidates who are not EU nationals should be permanent residents in Belgium or already hold a 'carte professionnelle' enabling them to work on an independent basis in Belgium.

The position will involve all aspects of research and writing of MLex comment and analysis articles on transactions of note which are subject to European, Member State and third country merger control laws. This will include carrying out jurisdictional analyses of transactions and a substantive analysis of competition issues in such transactions, as well as the tracking of such deals before and after notification to various competition authorities.

The position, reporting to the head of MLex's Merger Analysis Team, will also include responsibility for managing and overseeing a portfolio of current merger case files on a variety of sectors and some supervision of interns.
