Some knowledge of how the EU works may be advantageous, although there will be on-the-job training.

More important is that the candidate has a firm grasp of the basics of written journalism and the enthusiasm and intellectual curiosity to do well in a specialised newswire environment.

The internship is paid, and is a three-month position, rolled over on review for another three months. It is based in Brussels. Some guidance from current and previous interns is available as to accommodation/Brussels generally.

While there are currently no longer-term positions available, MLex has a good record of seeking to keep on trainees who prove themselves over the course of their internships.
